Introduction to Futures League Scoring

Scoring in the Futures League is designed to be simple, effective, and aligned with what matters most—fun, development, and fair competition. Our approach supports a positive experience for every athlete, while still capturing the spirit of competition in a way that's clear and easy to understand. By focusing on compulsory skills scored from 1 to 5 in 0.5 increments, the scoring system keeps things consistent and clear. It also allows athletes to showcase their individual flair through Shine Skills, which are also scored from 1 to 5 in 0.5 increments, with an added bonus available for increased complexity—striking a balance between structure and creativity. The below tables identifies what determines the score scale:

Awards and Banding

Depending on the level, athletes are awarded based on a combination of results including individual banded score ranges, apparatus-specific scores, overall athlete performance, and team achievements. Each division has a specific banding range that determines eligibility for individual medals, ensuring recognition is aligned with developmental expectations.
